

Welcome new members and guests!

Willow Eaton with KP Community Services gave a presentation on all of the services their organization provides for Key Peninsula. These services include:

Food Bank

Bread Closet - Clients shop for bread, bakery items & produce

Baskets - These are served twice a month and contain meats, produce, eggs, dairy and canned goods. Generally, each basket contains enough food to feed a family for three days. Commodities - A daily selection of canned goods, produce & protein.

Senior Meals

Freshly prepared meals served daily to seniors over the age of 60 for a donation of \$3.00. No one is turned away.

Senior Center

These services focus on the five dimensions of wellness: Intellectual, Emotional, Physical, Social, and Spiritual

We are working to transition to a new membership system.

A subcommittee has been convened to create a new website for the LIC.
